Dr Modak invited to be on International Sustainable Products Exchange (ISPX)

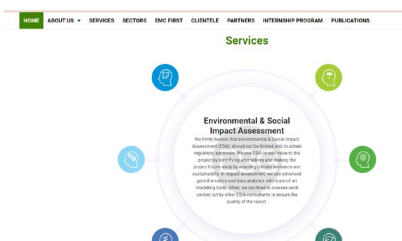
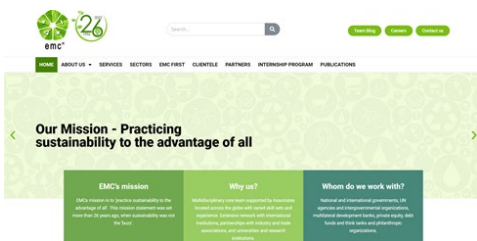
We are happy to inform you that Dr.Modak has been invited to be on the sustainability expert group to provide advise to the platform, the International Sustainable Products Exchange (ISPX). The platform will be operated by three firms - National Stock Exchange, the leading Indian stock exchange and the world's largest derivatives exchange (by trading volume); ECube, a pioneering ESG focused financial services platform and Chainflux, a Blockchain products firm. The Exchange will be located at GIFT City, a global financial hub located in a Special Economic Zone in the Indian state of Gujarat, with significant advantages on regulatory ease of doing business and taxation.

Dr.Modak's role will be to advise on ESG frameworks and standards, evangelize the purpose and ambition of ISPX and inter alia offer strategy inputs and advice on the product mix and new product ideas.

This platform will catalyze the availability of climate finance and access to a variety of important financial instruments that India and other markets urgently require, including Green Bonds, Sustainable Bonds, Voluntary and Regulated Carbon Credits, Green Equity, and Green and Sustainable REITs.

Global Sustainability Champions

In the memory of late Dadasaheb Rege, Principal of Balmohan Vidyamandir, March 19 is celebrated as the International Day of Balmohan. Dr Modak being an alumnus of Balmohan, Ekonnnect organized a week-long virtual event called "Global Sustainability Champions". The program focused on introducing sustainability to school students belonging to class 8 to 11.

130+ students from 6 countries showed interest. 30 students registered from India and UK. 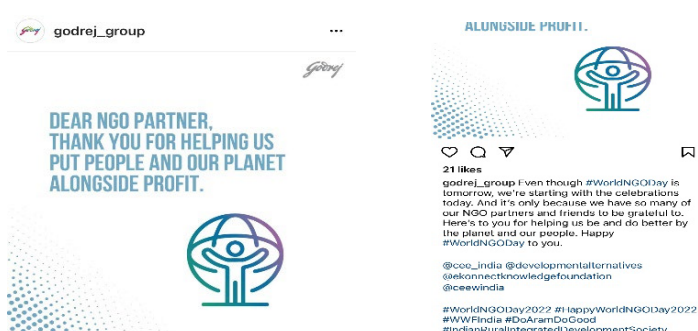
Speaking Engagements
